Dear Members and Fellows,

The NZAMM Executive, April 2020, approved the following fee rates effective this financial year. We have endeavoured to budget for growth of the Association and the Training programme, along with improved services to members.

NZAMM is the VEAB responsible for training in the Vocational Pathway towards a CAMM and vocational registration in Musculoskeletal Medicine.

This year there is a one-off levy on Fellows to cover some of the costs of Reaccreditation by the Medical Council of New Zealand for which we are currently preparing.

PROGRESS IN 2019: Over the last year we have worked hard to establish an updated website and this year we are working on a secure cloud-based document repository within a not-for-profit version of Microsoft 365 and SharePoint. Both changes will allow improved Training Programme record keeping and improved ways of keeping in touch with you all.

AFMM has been closed in Australia and New Zealand, but all NZ and Australian Fellows of the Faculty are able to join the newly established AFMM Incorporated (NZ) for a nominal membership fee. This will be billed by NZAMM and passed on to AFMM Inc.

Funds remaining in the original Faculty will be transferred to a Musculoskeletal Medicine research fund within **The Musculoskeletal Medicine Foundation**, a charitable trust currently under application proceedings towards registration as a Charitable Trust within NZ.

Your fees have remained the same as in 2019-20 apart from a decrease in the AFMM Levy for Fellows of \$120 and for trainees of \$100. Fellows (Australian Fellows voluntary) are asked to pay a one-off Levy towards covering some of the cost of Reaccreditation. This will offset internal costs of producing the application and a charge from the MCNZ which will be charged for the first time in 2020-21, being \$17,000 for VEABs with fewer than 300 members.

Your Invoice will list the charges and the 5% discount that will apply to Fellows should they choose to pay for the full charge by 20th May 2020.

BILLING NOW: While we know there will be some financial issues for you, it is important that NZAMM continue its' growth and development towards improved vocational training and a thriving membership. We look forward to a time when we can all meet again at Retreats and Conferences and travel is permitted. However, we are aware that this is not the easiest of times to receive a subscription fee demand.
